

WESTWARD LEAGUE RULES 2026/27

(Held under UK Athletics Rules)

PLEASE NOTE: All Clubs competing in the Westward League must be affiliated to England Athletics and include the discipline of Cross Country.

AGE GROUPS

Senior Men	Aged 18 or over on 31 st August 2027
U18 Men	16 & 17 on 31 st August 2027 (Year 11 & 12)
U16 Boys	14 & 15 on 31 st August 2027 (Year 9 & 10)
U14 Boys	12 & 13 on 31 st August 2027 (Year 7 & 8)
U12 Boys	10 & 11 on 31 st August 2027 (Year 5 & 6)

Senior Women	Aged 18 or over on 31 st August 2027
U18 Women	16 & 17 on 31 st August 2027 (Year 11 & 12)
U16 Girls	14 & 15 on 31 st August 2027 (Year 9 & 10)
U14 Girls	12 & 13 on 31 st August 2027 (Year 7 & 8)
U12 Girls	10 & 11 on 31 st August 2027 (Year 5 & 6)

U10 Boys and Girls -Min age 8 on the day (Year 4 and some Year 3)

REGISTRATION - All clubs must provide a full list of their competitors with registration numbers and dates of birth prior to the season start. This can be added to as the season continues *. If an athlete competes who is not registered the club have until the next fixture to provide the registration number otherwise any points gained will be removed.

Qualification date for Vet Categories is the date of the first fixture. Vets remain in this category for the season.

We must be informed of the details of any athlete added during the season on or before the day they compete.

SCORING

Senior Men – up to and including first five home score for ‘A’ Team, next five home score for ‘B’ Team etc.

Senior Women – up to and including first four home score for ‘A’ Team, next four home score for ‘B’ Team etc.

Vet Men – up to and including first four home score for ‘A’ Team, next four home score for ‘B’ Team etc. 200 points awarded for the first Vet Man home, 199 for second etc. 100 points awarded to first Vet Woman, 99 for second etc. Vet Women are based on the first 3 scorers.

All other age groups – up to and including first three home score for ‘A’ Team, next three home score for ‘B’ Team etc. (U18 Women will compete in their own age group and also score for the Senior Team).

Six League fixtures with best five results to score for both Team and Individual in the Senior categories only (see Event cancellation policy below). Points are allocated from 300 downwards in the Senior Men’s race, 200 downwards in the Senior Women’s race and 100 downwards for all other races. In the Veteran and Junior categories the best four scores will be used. In the event of a tie for Team or Individual the full six results will be taken into account (five for juniors and vets).

The first fixture will be run as a Relay event. League points will be awarded based on individual leg times (equal times will be awarded the same number of points).

No competitor may run for more than one Club in the League during the winter season and must be a First Claim member of that Club. In certain circumstances, bona fide Second Claim members may compete providing their First Claim club is not a member of the league (or full agreement has been granted by first claim club). **Anyone in this category must be approved/registered with the League Secretary prior to the first fixture.**

Guests are allowed to run at a cost of £3 per race.

Guests can only take part in two fixtures in a season and must be affiliated to England Athletics (or equivalent home country).

Club colours must be worn in accordance with UK Athletics' Rules. Failure to do so may lead to disqualification (i.e. no points shall be awarded).

For safety reasons music players or similar shall not be worn in any of the races. Any athlete who is seen with such will be disqualified.

Each Club must appoint a Team Manager to be responsible for ensuring that their athletes wear the correct allocated number. *Team Managers will need to ensure any new athletes are registered with the League and that a number has been allocated.

League numbers will be issued to each athlete for the entire season and used from fixture 2 onwards. Clubs will be responsible for these numbers and there will be a charge for replacements. Relay team numbers will be used for the first fixture. Team managers will need to declare their teams on the day

Team Managers are to be aware that all competitors must run in their respective age group. Any athlete competing in the wrong age group will be disqualified for that fixture.

A Club organising a fixture shall be responsible for that event and must ensure the Co-ordinator is given all results on the day. Organising Clubs must abide by the Rules of UK Athletics (refer to Cross Country Rules relevant to the granting of an EA Cross Country Licence).

Entrance fee for the season will be **£50** per Club/Organisation. **Entrance fee is payable PRIOR to the commencement of the season.** An additional £2 per senior athlete and £1 for juniors, per race, is payable in advance, or no later than one fixture in arrears. Fees should be paid by BACS wherever possible.

Results will be posted on the League website (see above) and e-mailed to clubs. Please ensure an up to date email address is provided at the start of the season.

AWARDS

First three overall individuals per age group, to include Masters awards as follows:

Men O/40, O/45, O/50, O/55, O/60, O/65

Women O/35, O/40, O/45, O/50, O/55, O/60

Awards in certain categories may be subject to entry.

First three teams per age group. If there are insufficient complete teams in any age group during the series, awards will be reduced accordingly.

Any proposed alterations or additions to the Rules are to be notified, in writing, to the League Secretary and a vote will be taken by paid up Clubs at the following AGM or EGM.

CANCELLATION OF FIXTURES

In the event that a fixture is cancelled for any reason. All clubs will be advised of the cancellation by email at least 24 hours before the planned day of the fixture.

All categories will then reduce the number of scoring races by one. i.e. Seniors score 4 from 5 and all others (including vets) score 3 from 5.

In the event of more than one cancellation the fixtures will reduce accordingly. If three fixtures are cancelled the awards will not be given out but any remaining fixtures would still continue.
